RSA Scholar Program

- ★ The RMHC program has been awarded a federal long-term training grant to increase the number of highly qualified rehabilitation counselors available to work within the vocational rehabilitation system.
- ★ This grant provides scholarship opportunities for students beginning in 2016. Award amounts are up to \$27,800.00.
- ★ Scholars will agree to work (for full pay and benefit) in the public, non-profit, or private vocational rehabilitation system after graduation for a designated period of time in exchange for tuition and other qualifying expenses.

Program Overview

- ★ The major purpose of the RSA academic scholarship award is to increase the supply of rehabilitation personnel available for employment as rehabilitation counselors in public and private sector and in nonprofit agencies involved in the vocational rehabilitation of individuals with disabilities.
- ★ The focus of the project is to integrate customized employment (CE) practices into the core curriculum in alignment with new legislation (WIOA) that requires public VR systems to add customized employment options to their menu of services.
